Only **full papers** may be submitted, preferably in pdf-format. Papers must be in **English** and should be submitted to: claudiu.albulescu@upt.ro

Paper presenters are expected to discuss one other paper during the workshop. The discussant assignments will be made by the workshop organizers at a later date. As the workshop intends to build a network in this research area, participation is welcome even without paper contributions.

Authors are allowed to submit more than one paper. All submitted papers will be peer reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process. Authors will be notified whether their paper is accepted for presentation at the workshop not later than September 1st, 2019.
