Job Offer Post doctoral Researcher- 2015-2017

Paris School of Economics (PSE) is inviting applications for a two-year postdoctoral fellowship starting in **Fall 2015**.

Background

A consortium comprising the Paris School of Economics (PSE) and led by Global Climate Forum (GCF) has won a European bid for conducting a research project on the linkages between climate change actions and sustainable development. The project is called *Green growth and win-win strategies for sustainable climate action (GREENWIN)* and the research director for PSE is Antoine Mandel.

Tasks

The main tasks in the job are the following

- Develop network-based models of technological diffusion
- Perform (i) analysis of the diffusion of low-carbon technologies and (ii) assessments of the associated macro-economic impacts, in particular in relation to sustainable development goals.
- Co-author scientific papers documenting the results of the project
- Co-author reports to the European commission on the diffusion of low-carbon technologies and associated macro-economic impacts
- Communicate and discuss results of the project with partners and stakeholders (in particular a global network of NGOs working in the field of sustainable development)
- Assist Antoine Mandel with the administration of the project.

Duration

Two years (with possible renewal).

Location

The job is located in the Paris School of Economics in Paris (MSE Campus, 13^{ème}).

Salary

The monthly gross salary is 2 750 €.

Requirements

This job offer is addressed to young doctors, or 'almost doctors', in economics, mathematics, complex systems or related fields with a strong quantitative perspective on social sciences. A strong interest in climate policy and sustainable development is preferable.

Applications are open both to French and to non-French nationals. Knowledge of French is not necessary.
