

The Institute for Advanced Sustainability Studies e.V. (IASS) is an international, interdisciplinary research institute located in Potsdam, financed by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research and the Federal State of Brandenburg. It is devoted to promoting science and research for global sustainability, particularly in the areas of climate change, the earth system and societal pathways to sustainability. We focus on the societal and political transformations that must take place if we are to achieve sustainability.
