

The French National Institute for Agricultural Research (INRA) seeks applicants for a full-time researcher position in environmental economics. This is a tenured position subject to a one-year probationary period. Prior knowledge of French is not required. The annual gross Salary is 25,000-31,000 euros before income taxes, depending on experience. The successful candidate will work in the INRA research center located in Montpellier (within the LAMETA unit).

**Qualifications:** The applicant should

- hold a PhD in Economics by September 2016;
- have the potential to conduct high quality research (a record of high quality research publications will be considered as an asset).

**Description of the research unit:**

[LAMETA](#) research covers several fields of economics, and focuses mainly on environmental and natural resource economics, behavioral and experimental economics, and on issues related to competition, regulation and network industries.

**Application and recruitment process**

The application must be submitted online through the internet job platform of the [French National Institute for Agricultural Research](#). The application process **opens on January 28, 2016**, and **closes on March 1, 2016**. Candidates will be able to download on the platform details on the position, the guide for applicants as well as the application file on the day applications open. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed during May-June 2016, and the final decision will be made before the end of July 2016. The successful candidate must be able to take up his or her appointment no later than December 2016.
