## CONFERENCE PUBLIC POLICIES IN THE CONTEXT OF GLOBAL CHANGES: Climate Change, Biodiversity and Food Sustainability Paris, May 31<sup>st</sup> –June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018



## Aim and Topic.

Global changes such as climate change, international trade agreements, loss in global biodiversity and volatility of world food prices pose challenges for agricultural production, the sustainability of renewable resources, and the well-being of consumers. These global threats require not only the analysis of existing national and international policies, but also require thinking about the design of innovative policies that could reconcile economic, environmental and social goals. Policies that will be discussed in conference include this agricultural. environmental, land use and food policies, and trade measures. The objective of the conference is to discuss recent theoretical and empirical contributions in economics on these topics.

### Format.

The academic conference is run over two days, and comprises four thematic sessions. There are four paper presentations in each session and there are no parallel sessions. The number of participants will be limited to around 100.
