The selected applicant is expected to **begin his/her appointment around April-May 2019**. The appointment is for **24 months** (with a mid-term review). The researcher is expected to spend time at Paris Dauphine University, Cergy Pontoise University and Paris Nanterre University.

Additional research funds will be allocated to the post-doctoral researcher to cover the expenses related to presentations at international conferences, or for carrying out economic experiments.

2-Year Postdoctoral Position in Economics specializing in Behavioral Economics, Experimental Economics and Environmental Economics

Paris Dauphine University, Cergy Pontoise University and Paris Nanterre University invite applications for a 2-year, fully funded postdoctoral position in Economics and Management, with an emphasis on Behavioral Economics, Experimental Economics and Environmental Economics.

The successful candidate will be taking part in an ADEME (French Environment & Energy Management Agency) funded project about recycling waste behavior and involves designing and running field and lab experiments as well as data analysis. The project is promoted by three universities in Ile-de-France and brings together researchers in economics and management sciences. The research actions will target different audiences (students, staff and external stakeholders) and different locations (classrooms, corridors, offices of staff...)

Missions of the post-doctoral researcher

The postdoctoral researcher will be involved in different planned actions in the research project, and in particular:

- Review of the literature in management and economics sciences on waste management;
- Analysis of observations and quantitative surveys to better understand the practices of university users in sorting waste;
- Designing and running lab and field experiments to identify measures leading to increasing participation in waste sorting
- Dissemination and diffusion operations, in particular the final conference that will take place at the end of the second year.

The implication degree of the postdoctoral researcher in the different tasks planned will be decided between the postdoctoral researcher and the research team involved in the research.

There are no teaching duties involved.

Qualifications

- Applicants should have a PhD in Economics, or be close to finishing their PhD (It is expected that the candidate PhD defend takes place before the start of the post doc)
- He/she is expected to possess strong analytical skills and have a commitment to research excellence. He/she should also display a high level of team spirit;
- Applicants should be fluent in English. A reasonable standard of French is required;
- Strong skills in analyzing data. Experience with econometric software such as STATA, Matlab, or R is an asset is necessary;
- Experience in conducting field and/or lab experiments;
- Theoretical and/or applied research using both analytical and numerical methods in one or more of the following areas is requested:

1. Behavioral/Experimental economics

2. Environmental and natural resource economics

Working conditions

The selected applicant is expected to begin his/her appointment around April 2019. The appointment is for 24 months (with a mid-term review). Gross salary is around 2750-2800 euros per month.

The researcher is expected to spend time in the three universities involved in the project.

Paris Dauphine University will be the main employer. The postdoctoral researcher will have an office and all the materials necessary to the research work.

Research funds will be allocated to the post-doctoral researcher to cover all expenses related to presentations at international conferences.
