Two days of scientific presentations in **economics** and debates on **climate** and **environmental issues** in **cities**.

Call for papers

Urbanization is one of the major facts of the 21st century: of the nine billion people on the planet by 2050, more than two-thirds will be urban [United Nations - 2018]. Cities are also both **vectors of environmental degradations** (70% of global greenhouse gas emissions comes from urban areas) and particularly **vulnerable** in the face of **climate change** and its many **local repercussions**. Ecological transitions in this context will consist in simultaneously acting to **reduce their ecological footprint** and **improving their resilience**.

The **13th FAERE Thematic Workshop** will be an opportunity to discuss these issues. We therefore await any proposal for **empirical** or **theoretical economic** paper that can shed light on :

- urban forms, spatial planning and energy efficiency;
- transportation in urban and peri-urban areas and mobility practices;
- climate and environmental resilience of cities;
- urban pollution and public health issues;
- the management of resources and/or biodiversity in the city;
- circular economy and urban metabolism;
- the digitization of territories and the models of « Smart Cities »;
- the design and effectiveness of public environmental policies in the city...

We are waiting for your proposals (extended summary or full article) **no later than** April 19, 2023. Submissions should be sent by email to the address: JT.FAERE23@gmail.com.

Proposals will be selected by the **scientific committee** after a **double proofreading procedure.** Oral presentation will be <u>in English</u> and followed by a discussion. As this event is also intended to be open to other scientific disciplines than economics, **particular attention will be paid to works proposing an interdisciplinary approach** as well as to contributions submitted by young researchers or doctoral students.
